## Discounts Based on Total Hours

When posting tuition fees for classes with theBilling Method - By Total Hours the tuition fees are calculated using the Fee Schedule. The Fee Schedule defines how much is charged for each increment of time spent in class and allows you to build in a discount for multiple hours of class time, aka multiple classes.

## Example:

- A student who takes a one hour class is charged a tuition fee of $\$ 60$
- A student who takes 2 one hour classes (2 hours) is charged tuition fees of $\$ 100$
- A student who takes 3 one hour classes (3 hours) is charged tuition fees of $\$ 150$

| Total Hours Fee Schedule |  |  |  |

|  |  | Total Hours | Tuition Fee |
| 1 | T | 1.00 | 60.00 |
| 2 | T | 2.00 | 100.00 |
| 3 | - | 3.00 | 150.00 |

The hours discount given for two hours is $\$ 20$; the student was charged only $\$ 100$ for 2 hours vs $\$ 120$ ( $\$ 60$ for one hour $\times 2$ ).

The hours discount given for three hours is $\$ 30$; the student was charged only $\$ 150$ for 3 hours vs \$180 (\$60 for one hour x 3).
