The Class Skills/Levels report displays the skills each student enrolled in the class is working on. Go to the Modules (menu) > Skills > Class Skills/Levels.

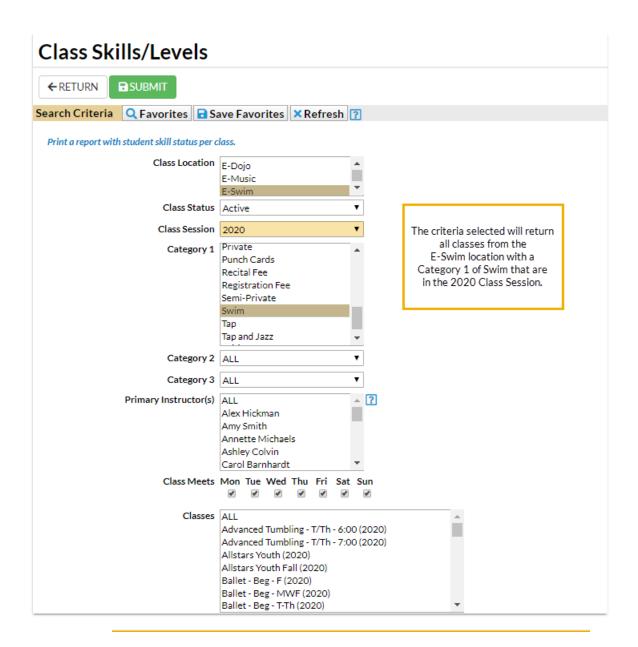
The report can be displayed in 3 different formats, determined by the display setting of your choice:

- ★ The **Skills Report** is a great way to see a list of skills and skill status for students in a class.
- The **Skills Worksheet** is helpful in updating skills for classes when the Staff Portal isn't feasible.
- ★ The **Skills Progress Report** is a report card that shows parents how their student is progressing in your program.

The Search Criteria selected here will determine the information included, regardless of the display format chosen.

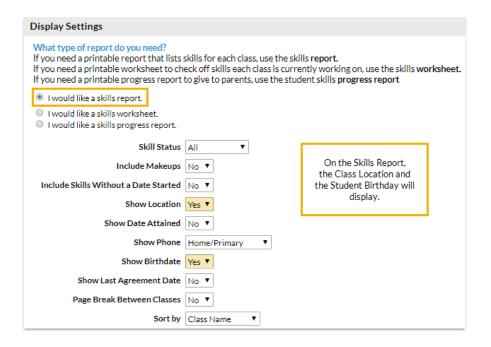



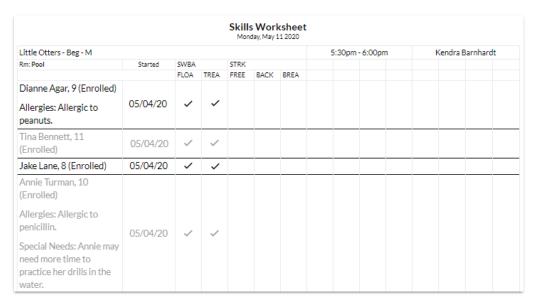
Use the Display Settings to format your report:

Business Scenario

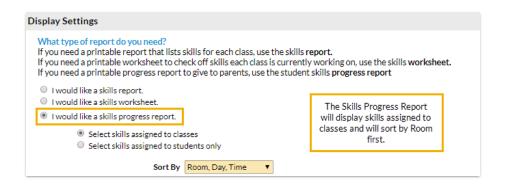
