The report can be displayed in 3 different formats, determined by the display setting of your choice:

- * The **Skills Report** is a great way to see a list of skills and skill status for students in a class.
- ***** The **Skills Worksheet** is helpful in updating skills for classes when the Staff Portal isn't feasible.
- The Skills Progress Report is a report card that shows parents how their student is progressing in your program.




